You and your staff are invited to a one-day ***Essentials of Vehicle Collision Investigation*** course. Much of the material used is from an extended course developed and presented by the US Department of Transportation for bus collisions. We shortened and simplified the course so more school staff can attend.

The purpose of the course is to help attendees understand basic terms and requirements for vehicle accident investigation. The investigator will recognize their role apart from that of law enforcement. Upon successful completion of the course, the student should be able to gather information about a collision to support the district in case of legal action, and to prevent recurrence.

The following topics are a portion of information the fast-paced course will cover:

- Chain of Events, Tools of the Trade
- Road Signs, Rules and Markings
- Evidence Identification and Analysis
- Interpreting and Measuring Road Marks
- Tire Forensics and Brake Systems
- Field Measurements and Sketching
- Collision Investigation Photography
