

# Notice of Political Subdivision Workers' Compensation Alliance Requirements for Work-Related Injuries

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## Dear Employee:

Your employer has chosen the Political Subdivision Workers' Compensation Alliance (the Alliance) to manage the health care and treatment you may receive if you are injured at work. The Alliance includes a list of health care providers who are trained in treating work related injuries and getting people back to work safely.

## When you are injured at work:

Tell your supervisor or employer immediately. For emergencies, you may go to the nearest emergency room. Otherwise, you must choose a treating doctor from the list on the website below. Your employer will assist with any questions about how to obtain treatment. You may also contact your adjuster at the TASB Risk Management Fund (the Fund) for any questions about treatment for a work-related injury. The Fund is your employer's workers' compensation coverage provider. They work with your employer to ensure you receive timely health care. The goal is to return you to work as soon as it is safe to do so.
