

Where to Go For Employee Medical Care

Check your symptoms before calling an ambulance or going to the ER



Telemedicine

Symptoms or injuries: Bites; slips, trips, and falls; bruises, scrapes, and cuts; skin conditions; minor wounds or burns; respiratory infections; cold and/or flu symptoms

Estimated cost: \$90-\$210



Doctor Office or Health Clinic

Symptoms or injuries: Fever below 104; animal and insect bites; allergies; bronchitis; sprains and minor broken bones; cuts and bleeding; vomiting; diarrhea; and/or minor pain; respiratory infections; cold and/or flu symptoms

Estimated cost: \$90-\$400



Urgent Care

Symptoms or injuries: Fever below 104; bites; broken bones; sprains; cuts and bleeding; minor burns; high blood pressure greater than 180/120 without symptoms; and/or minor pain

Estimated cost: \$300-\$500



Emergency Room

Symptoms or injuries: High blood pressure greater than 180/120 with symptoms such as chest pain; fever above 104; paralysis; loss of consciousness; severe burns; severe pain; and/or shortness of breath that persists

Facility and physician cost: \$2,300-\$5,500

Ground ambulance cost: \$800-\$1,500

Air ambulance cost: \$10,000-\$45,000



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
